

2010 CPLL UMPIRE PROGRAM

SCHEDULING:

There are approximately 65 umpires this year, so scheduling games was a bit more challenging. A and AA Divisions have been merged cutting drastically number of games available. Little League has mandated that adult umpires be at every game. As a result we were forced to schedule as many adults as possible. Games that there is not an adult, home team will provide an adult umpire to sit in the field, and call the game should there be lightening. This requirement was presented to CPLL after we started umpire registration.

As a result of the requirements presented to us, we have attempted to schedule remaining games as fairly as possible. Carla and I will attempt to alter the schedule if needed to get everyone games.

As you know games have been scheduled already throughout the season, but I expect situations to arise that people need to cancel. You should attempt to find a replacement and inform Carla and me. If you can't find a replacement make sure Carla and I are informed so we can send out a blast email.

WEATHER:

You should always check www.cpll.org to get the latest status on games. There is not a CPLL hotline to call. The league will give updated status on field conditions.

FEES AND VOUCHERS:

After reviewing different Leagues, we have decided to pay by experience. There also is not a distinction between working the plate or the field. As a result of fewer games, I wanted to make the pay similar for each position.

You should print out the voucher on the website, and bring it to your game. Make sure you have it signed by a manager. Please return it to me every 2 weeks and I will send it to the treasurer for payment. You may get voucher to me by:

Every 2 weeks I will scan all vouchers to the treasurer, and you will receive your check from him. PLEASE make sure you have your address on the voucher.

CONFLICTS WITH MANAGERS:

All coaches and managers attend positive coaching alliance seminars. Under no circumstance should they ever be allowed to intimidate you or make you feel

uncomfortable. They should not question balls and strikes. Rule of thumb, be consistent with your calls.

A manager may request a time out and seek clarification of a rule, but the manager should present you with the rule and rulebook. It is not your responsibility to present the rulebook.
